General: The Garden State Games Figure Skating Championship is a qualifying competition for the National State Games of America Championships (SGA). Skaters may enter each event that they qualified for by virtue of placing first, second or third at their local State Games competition. All events at SGA are solo events, except for synchronized team and Spotlight. Skaters that qualified in an event offered at SGA may add an additional event from Spotlight, Footwork, or Dance. Skaters may not add a restricted free skate, an unrestricted free skate, a short program, or a compulsory moves event.

Rules: The competition will be conducted according to the rules for the 2009-2010 competition season as set forth in the U.S. Figure Skating rulebook and the corresponding ISI test level, *except where noted*. This competition will be judged under the ordinal 6.0 system as the National State Games competition will be judged under the 6.0 system.

Eligibility: All skaters must reside in New Jersey for more than 30 days or be a member of a New Jersey USFS Club. Skaters may not have skated in any other 2010 State Games Competition. All entrants must be members in good standing of clubs having membership in U.S. Figure Skating, be individual members of U.S. Figure Skating, Basic Skills or members of ISI. Test requirements are as of **May 3, 2010**. Skaters may skate up one level from their highest test passed (**does not** include Basic Skills skaters). Any skater who was a first place winner in any 2009-2010 qualifying US Skating competition (North/South Atlantics, Easterns) or prior Garden State Games competition must skate the next level, excluding Senior and Adult Events. Skaters will be grouped by test level, ability and age.

Entries: Entries must be postmarked no later than **May 3, 2010**. Post office cancellation is required. No metered, hand stamped, certified or registered mail will be accepted. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) reserves the right to limit entries in each category and the right to combine, divide or cancel groups. No changes may be made to a competitor's application once the deadline has passed. Read and sign the Waiver that is located on the bottom portion of the application. Applications without the signed waiver will be returned. Late applications will be accepted at the discretion of the competition committee and will require **DOUBLE THE FEES**.

No refunds will be granted after May 3, 2010 for any reason other than events cancelled by the LOC (USFSA# 3235)

Fees: Include a check or money order payable to the Garden State Games. Cash payments will not be accepted. There will be a \$35 handling charge for returned checks.

Registration/Music: The registration desk will open one hour before the first event. Participants are advised to be present **at least** one hour before their event in case the competition is running early. CDs are required. **Only CDs are allowed. Music on cassette tapes or CDR-W's will NOT be accepted.** Music must be clearly marked with the skater's name, level, and length of program and submitted one (1) hour before the start of the skater's event. The North Jersey Figure Skating Club, Inc. assumes no responsibility or liability for damage or loss of CDs. All competitors **must** have a duplicate CD with them at the rink. The North Jersey Figure Skating Club, Inc. will provide dance music.

Schedules: Schedules will be available 7-10 days prior to the start of the competition and will **ONLY** be posted on the North Jersey FSC website: www.northjerseyfsc.org. Please note that the schedule is prepared by the Referee after the close of entries and is based strictly on the number of events and competitors and the availability of judges. No changes to the schedule will be allowed to accommodate personal or family conflicts. **NO SCHEDULES WILL BE MAILED – CHECK THE WEBSITE.**

- Liability:** U.S. Figure Skating, the North Jersey FSC, Inc., Garden State Games, The National Congress of State Games, and the Ice Vault Arena accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in these championships.
- Limitations:** *We may not be able to accommodate all entries.* If limits must be placed on any event, entries will be based on the postmark date. Anyone closed out of an event will be notified and the applicable portion of the fee returned. Under no other circumstances will a refund be given including conflicting family activities, injuries, illness or deaths in the family (USFSA# 3235). Events with one entry ***will not*** be cancelled.
- Awards:** In all events, medals will be awarded to First, Second, and Third, place winners.
- Facility:** The ice surface at Ice Vault Arena measures 200' by 85'.
- Practice Ice:** Practice ice may be available and will be announced at a later date.
- Apparel:** Official GSG apparel may be ordered with your application. See attached order form. You will receive your apparel at the competition. Extra shirts are generally **not** sold at the competition. Check the North Jersey FSC website at www.northjerseyfsc.org.

From Rt-23: Rt-23 to Alps Road exit (Wayne). (Rt-23 North exits directly onto Alps Road. From Rt-23 South proceed to stop sign and turn right on Alps Road.) Proceed approx. 2 miles to the traffic light at Alps and Rutzer Roads. Turn extreme right on Rutzer and proceed approx. 1 mile to the traffic light at Rutzer and Valley Roads. Turn left on Valley Road. Follow Valley Rd. for approx. 1 mile through first traffic light (Hamburg Turnpike). The next traffic light is Barbour Pond Drive, turn left. Rink is approx. 150 yards on right.

From Rt-46: Take route 46 West to the exit for Riverview Drive – Little Falls/Wayne. Take the exit and at the light, make a left and immediately get in the right lane where you will make the right turn to go onto Riverview Drive in Wayne. Go 5 lights on Riverview to Valley Road (golf course on right). Make a right onto Valley Road. Go 6 lights to Barbour Pond Road. Turn left onto Barbour Pond Road. Rink is approximately 150 yards on the right. Turn right onto Nevins Drive.

From Garden State Parkway: Garden State Parkway South to exit 159, Rt-80 West. Proceed to Rt-23 North or Rt-46 West. *See directions from Route 23 or Route 46.

From NYC (Washington Bridge/Lincoln Tunnel): Follow Rt-46 West, Rt-80 West, or Rt-3 West. Proceed to Rt-23 North or Route 46 West and follow direction above.

From Rt-208: Rt-208 to Ewing Ave./Franklin Lakes exit. (Rt-208 North proceeds to stop sign, then left on Ewing. Rt-208 South proceed to stop sign, turn right on Ewing.) Proceed to end of Ewing Avenue. Turn left on High Mountain Road. Continue approx. 1 mile to fork. Take right fork on Belmont Ave. and proceed approx. 2 miles to 2nd traffic light. Artistic

Competitors will be judged on the use and quality of edges, footwork, spins, spirals, as well as flow and expressing the rhythm and character of the music. Jumps are allowed, but will be judged only on the quality of the jump not the difficulty of the jump. Props are not permitted. Costumes that “shed” (feathers, sequin, etc.) will result in a penalty to the skater. Competitors will be grouped according to freestyle level.

Open to Pre-Preliminary /Preliminary 1:30 max, Pre-Juvenile/Juvenile 2:00 max;

Intermediate/Novice: 2:30 max, Junior/Senior 2:30 max and Adult 2:00 max.

Skaters competing in Basic Skills events (Snow Plow Sam/Tots – Basic 8), and No-Test *may not* enter this event.

Showcase

Emphasis is placed on the illustration of character through music, props, costume and style. Costumes or props that “shed” (feathers, sequin, etc.) will result in a penalty to the skater. Props are limited to those the skater can carry or push onto the ice in one trip unassisted. Props may not include flame, smoke or any substance, which may alter the surface of the ice. Live props are not permitted. Skaters will be judged on costume, props, music, choreography, audience appeal and technical merit (only on style, flow and confidence of presentation). Skaters will be grouped according to freestyle level. **Open to Pre-Preliminary through Senior and Adult. 2:00 max.**

Skaters competing in Basic Skills events (Snow Plow Sam/Tots – Basic 8) and No Test *may not* enter this event.

Compulsory Moves

Compulsory moves eligibility is the same as for the Freestyle categories. Moves are skated without music and MOVES MAY BE SKATED IN ANY ORDER. Connecting steps are allowed except where stated. Additional jumps or spins are not permitted and will result in a deduction. Failed elements may not be retried. Skaters competing in Basic Skills events (Snow Plow Sam/Tots – Basic 8/Basic Freeskate 1-6) **may not** enter this event.

Moves in the Field

Skaters will complete 3 moves per category as determined below. Where necessary, a draw to determine direction, edge or starting foot will be posted 15 minutes prior to the event. Move numbers are designated. Skaters competing in Basic Skills (Snow Plow Sam/Tots – Basic 8) **may not** enter this event.
